## **Explanation of Program Costs**

The FVHS Theatre is an exciting program that requires an investment of time, talent and treasure. To continue this level of excellence requires a significant Operating Budget. The Huntington Beach Unified School Districts provides only a small portion of the funding required to run this successful program.

We receive approximately \$650 for the year from the school district and nothing from the state for the entire year. The fall and spring fair share contributions only begin to cover all of the FVHS Theatre Production operating expenses.

**Theatre Production Operational Expenses: \$34,250.00**<sup>1</sup>

#### **Operational Fair Share Contributions:**

The operational fair share contribution for the 2013 Spring semester:

#### • \$250 per student, which is due tonight.

~Your fair share contribution will immediately begin to provide for the cost of scripts, royalties, technical and acting support, costumes, props, set, advertising, and other production costs.

#### **Volunteer Hours:**

In addition to the fair share contributions necessary to produce this semester's two excellent shows, each family is asked to volunteer their time.
